

SECTION I PHOTOGRAPHY

Please note the closing date for entries will be 22 June 2011, photo's can be submitted until 28 July 2011 (provided it was already entered before 22 June 2011). No late entries can be accepted as all entries are simultaneously handed over for adjudication.

Entry Fee

R30.00 per photo.

GENERAL RULES

- Participants may enter one photo per category.
- Photo's can be e-mailed to the organizers at wak@cmrw.co.za to reach us by 28 July 2011.
- Photo size must not exceed 1mb and must be sized as follows:



- The picture must be clearly coded, made up as follows:
 - Initials of photographer, i.e. MK
 - Section and category of entry, i.e. I.2
 - Title of photo, i.e. dejected

Thus: MK / I.2 / Dejected

This code must be on the entry form, and must also serve as the “subject” of the e-mail.

ADJUDICATION

The adjudication of Primary and High School students will be done on their respective levels and in the open section adjudication will be done on professional standards in the category *Nature*, *Pictorial* and *Sport*. The categories *Night* and *Photo Journalistic* will only be adjudicated on professional standards.

CATEGORIES

- I1. Nature
- I2. Pictorial
- I3. Sport
- I4. Night
- I5. Photo journalistic
- I6. Theme

I.1 Nature

Photos of animals, nature, plants etc. Only minimal digital manipulation is allowed in this category. No human element may be captured, i.e. no telephone poles, power lines, fences etc. Photos of pets are not classified as nature photography. No cloning, monochrome or sepia is allowed.

I.2 Pictorial

Any photo not covered by any of the other categories may be entered under this category. Digital manipulation is allowed.

I.3 Sport

Any photo in the practicing of sport falls under this category. Minimum digital manipulation is allowed, but no cloning, monochrome or sepia is allowed.

I.4 Night

Any photo taken during night time, for example “night scapes”. Only natural light may be used.

I.5 Photo Journalistic

This category caters for “newspaper photos”. Any photo portraying an emotion or activity with a narrative touch, will fall under this category.

I.6 Theme

A photo is taken with a prescribed theme at mind. (The theme chosen will thus be the title of the photo in this category).

- Autumn
- The color of love
- “Oh my dear!”
- Aren’t you beautiful?
- In silence I find peace.
